

What else might I qualify for in TCCAA's Emergency Services

- **Appliance Management Program** will examine electrical use in the home (computerized audit) and replace light bulbs and refrigerators when needed.
- **Weatherization Assistance Program** assists income eligible individuals and families to permanently reduce their energy consumption and increase energy efficiency. Energy audits conducted will determine the need for insulation, weather stripping and pipe sealer.
- **Boiler Repair/Replacement** provides boiler repair services and replacement for heating systems that are beyond repair.
- **Good Neighbor Fund** grant provides assistance for people who are experiencing a financial crisis in regards to heat or electric source. (may be eligible for both heap and gnf assistance)

Basic Human Needs-Safety Net in Times of Need!

Fuel Assistance (LiHEAP): Help paying fuel bills to reduce home heating costs

Food Bank Commodities Distribution: Monthly distribution of canned goods

Emergency Food/Shelter Vouchers: to support nutritional/housing needs

Emergency Housing: Assist with Rental, security deposit, mortgage assistance

Emergency Basic Human Needs: Funds to help when no other financial assistance available

SNAP Outreach: Assistance with Food Stamp Application/questions through partnership with the URI Outreach program

Tax Preparation: Free tax preparation and electronic filing through the VITA program

Furniture Bank Referral: Assistance through RI Donation Exchange Program

What do I usually need to bring?

- Income documentation for previous 4 weeks.
- Current electric bill
- Current heating bill
- Social Security Cards for all household members
- Birth Certificates for all household members
- Photo ID for applicant
- If rental, copy of lease or rental agreement
- If homeowner, proof of ownership
- Proof of residence i.e., current utility bill
