COVID-19 SAFETY POLICIES

For the health, safety and well-being of all, the following policies are in order:

- If you are sick, please stay home! If you have a fever, cough, shortness of breath, contact your health care provider. If you had any exposure to anyone who has symptoms please remain at home.
- 2021 Membership – Your membership will need to be current in order to participate in classes, programs and activities.
- Mask Wearing – A face mask covering is optional upon arrival. If state guidelines require that a mask or cloth face covering must be worn by individuals who are not fully vaccinated for COVID-19 while indoors in a public space, participants who are not fully vaccinated must wear a mask or cloth face covering while inside the Mancini Center. Masks are not required during class as long as 6 feet social distancing is maintained.
- Arrival – Arrive 15 minutes prior to class start time. Hand sanitizer is available upon entering and is provided in all areas of the center. Members will scan their Mancini Center key card and proceed into the dining room.
- Entrance – Members will enter through the front entrance and exit through the side door (patio side) once class has ended. Unfortunately, there will be no lingering inside the center as we will need to sanitize before the next class.
- Classes – All classes will be conducted in the dining room as this is our largest area. Windows can be opened to allow fresh air to circulate. Tables and chairs have been rearranged to accommodate larger classes.
- Social Distancing – Social distancing of 6 feet must be maintained at all times. Physical contact such as shaking hands is not permitted.
- Water/Food – Water bottles are suggested. The Center has a water bottle filler located outside the dining room where classes will take place. No outside food may be brought into the building.
- Restrooms – Restrooms have COVID-19 protocols in place, limiting the number of individuals in the restroom at one time.
- Current programs are subject to change.
- We reserve the right to screen members who are in the Center and are showing symptoms of COVID-19.
- We reserve the right to decline services to anyone who does not adhere to the policies.
