

Mask mandate takes effect at the Mancini Center

Effective Monday, December 20, 2021, per Executive Order of Governor Dan McKee and the Town of North Providence, the North Providence Mancini Center will require masks or proof of vaccination for all those who enter the senior center. There are no exceptions.

The Mancini Center will continue to operate as usual providing the highest quality of senior services, fitness classes and programs to meet the needs of our senior members.

Upon reopening June 1st, the Mancini Center instituted COVID policies. These policies have remained in place as our highest priority is the health, safety and well-being of all. We will continue to fully operate following the same polices below.

MANCINI CENTER COVID POLICIES

- If you are sick, please stay home. If you have a fever, cough and/or shortness of breath, contact your health care provider.
- Proof of vaccination is required to enter. All those who are not vaccinated are required to wear a mask. There are no exceptions.
- Social distance 6 feet at all times.
- Hand sanitizer is provided in all areas of the center. Please use upon entering and exiting.
- Water bottles are allowed. For your convenience, a water bottle filler is located outside the dining room.
- Not allowed: Sharing of weights, balls, resistance bands and Zumba sticks. No sharing of food or snacks.
- All classes and programs are subject to change.
- We reserve the right to screen senior members who are in the center and are showing symptoms of COVID-19.
- We reserve the right to decline services to anyone who does not adhere to the center's policies.
